BOARDING STUDENTS: WHAT TO BRING

You may be wondering, "What should I bring to campus?" The following list will help you as you begin to imagine yourself living and learning at Cushing Academy.

Cushing provides every boarding student with a standard twin bed, desk, desk lamp, wooden desk chair, bureau, closet space, and trash can.

BEDDING

- Sheets (2 sets), pillow, pillowcases (4), blankets, and comforters for a standard size twin bed
- Bed risers to increase the height of the bed and allow for more storage under the bed (optional)

ELECTRONICS

- Cell phone with a United States' phone number connected to a wireless carrier. The phone cannot rely solely on Wi-Fi to place a phone call. Cushing requires that a student's voicemail is set up and can receive messages. AT&T has the best coverage in Ashburnham.
- Personal computer or tablet
- Surge protector for electronics
- Alarm clock (other than a cell phone)
- Flashlight and spare batteries

LAUNDRY

- Laundry basket and detergent
- Some families may decide to use <u>E&R Laundry Service</u>. (eandrcleaners.com)

BATHROOM

- Towels (2)
- Washcloths (2)
- Toiletries
- Shower Caddy (A small basket or case for carrying toiletries)
- Flip-flops or similar shoes for the shower

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

- Clothes hangers
- Bookbag or backpack
- Personal reusable water bottle
- Specialized sports equipment as needed
- Umbrella
- Basic school supplies
- Safe or lockbox for securing valuables.*
 *Please note that the Office of Student Affairs will need to access student safes to ensure the safety of all students on campus.

ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME

- Air conditioner units
- Electric teakettles
- Personal refrigerators
- · Microwaves, air fryers, toaster ovens, or hot plates
- Coffee pots/personal coffee makers (e.g., Keurig machines)
- Candles, matches, lighters, incense
- Halogen lamps
- Irons
- · Space heaters, electric blankets, or heating pads
- Televisions and computer monitors over 32"
- Furniture not provided by Cushing, including bean bag chairs, inflatable furniture, couches and futons
- Knives, including Swiss Army
- Pets of any kind
- Decorative string lights
- Valuables/irreplaceable items
